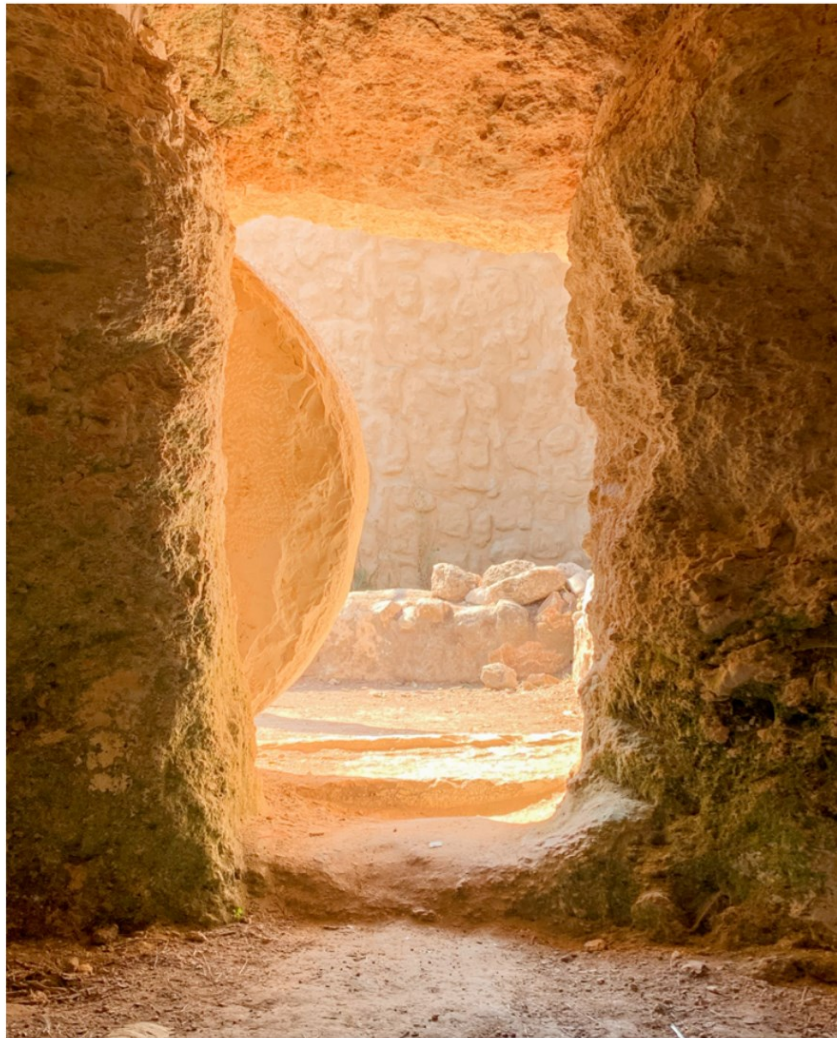

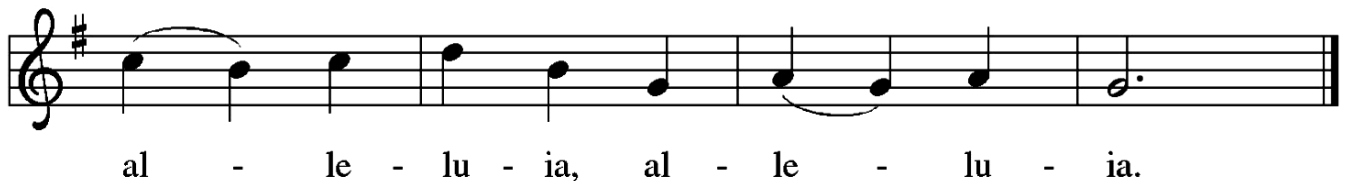
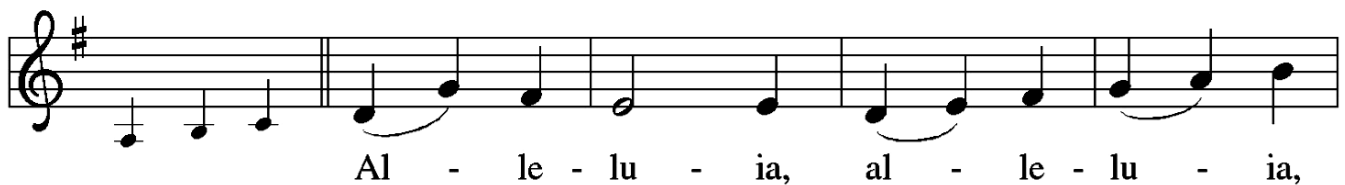
LESSON

Colossians 3:1-4

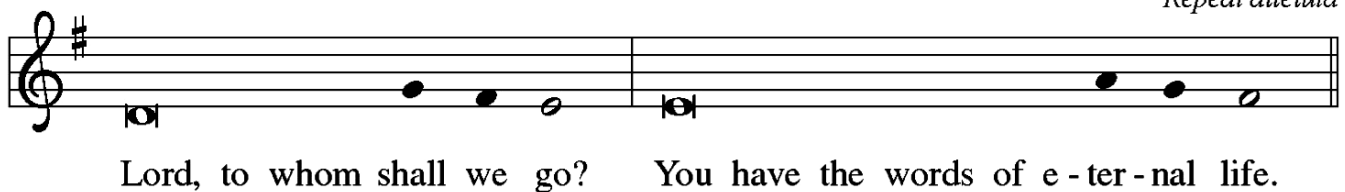
Easter means new life for us as it first meant new life for Christ. His resurrection reshapes the entire focus and motivation for our lives since we are now hidden with the risen Christ in God.




THE LORD'S PRAYER
